RULES

- 1) Participants may compete in both categories
- 2) Fishing from shore or boat
- 3) Kansas fishing regulations apply/bait is allowed
- 4) Measure all bass 12" and over to the nearest 1/4"
- 5) Measure all catfish 12" and over to the nearest 1/4"
- 6) All other species 8" and over to the nearest 1/4"

Chase Co State Lake is located approximately 70 miles NE of Wichita, Ks. The lake is wind protected by the Flint Hills and has unusually clear water. The lake boasts 3 types of bass, crappie, catfish, bluegill, walleye, and saugeye. The dam can be walked and fished easily by shore fishermen and there are 3 rock fishing piers with fish feeders along west side of the lake. Lake can be reached from Elmdale, Ks. on highway 50...go east 3 miles on the only blacktop going east out of Elmdale. The lake is also 3 miles west of Cottonwood Falls on same blacktop.
